LOCATION: Bear Creek Pool
(Off King George Highway, east on 88th Ave.)

FACILITIES:

- 8 lane; 25 meter pool with lots of room for club tents
- Sea Lions will be operating their own concession.
- Breakfast, lunch and snacks available.

SCHEDULE: Warm-ups supervised by a coach start at 6:40 am.
Lanes assigned on morning of the meet

MEET FORMAT:

- "A/B" Meet with "A" FINALS
- Each competitor may enter 4 individual events and 2 relays.
- Relays will be swum as timed finals after completion of heats
- Finals will follow relays after a short break if necessary.
- Events with only one heat will be swum as a timed final in the morning
- **THERE WILL BE NO DECK ENTRIES AT THIS MEET!**
 - Entries Must be in by June 25 2010 9pm
 - Entries must be e-mailed to gwcurl@telus.net
 - Entries must be submitted using the "Export Meet Entries" function in "Hy-Tek's" Team Manager "please include team roster".
 - Provide name and telephone number of computer contact person.
- Late entries and scratches will be accepted until Monday 31 9pm, @ gwcurl@telus.net. Please include swimmer's BCSSA number with all late entries.
 - Please note fees must be submitted to the Clerk of the Course Saturday, July 3 by 10:00 a.m. - cheques made payable to: "SL/CLO". Individual Events: \$7.00 and relays: \$8.00.
- Coaches must provide the names of swimmers on relays by 10:00 a.m. on the day of the meet to the Clerk of the Course.

"S" and "O" SWIMMERS:

- "O" swimmers may swim with "S" swimmers in heats
- "O" swimmers must be clearly marked "O" on meet entries

RELAYS:

- "S" relays must have 4 - "S" swimmers "
- An "O" swimmer on a relay team causes that team to be classified as Exhibition.
- Relays will be swum as timed finals.

AWARDS & SCORING:

- Ribbons for 1st to 8th place for both "A" and "B" swimmers from Div 1 to 4
- Ribbons for 1st to 8th place for Div 5 to 8 (no A/B distinction)
- Aggregate and Runner-Up Awards for both "A" and "B" swimmers from Div. 1-4
- Aggregate and Runner-Up Awards for Div 5 to 7 (no A/B distinction)
- Individual Points: 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 from 1st to 8th place.
- Relay Points: 18, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2 from 1st to 8th place

Points are awarded on the following basis:

- "B" swimmers are awarded points for their "B" swim only (preliminaries). If they are allowed to swim in Finals, no points are awarded for their final swim.
- "A" swimmers are awarded points for their final swim only.

RULES:

- BCSSA Rules and Regulations used as a guide.
- Timing System: We will be using the Colorado Dolphin Electronic Stopwatch timing system with three (3) electronic watches per lane. The watches will be started automatically by the starting system and finished manually by the timers. We will use USS Timing Rule 102.17.5B for Semi-Automatic timing as follows:
 1. If two of the three button or watch times agree, that shall be the time for that timing system.
 2. If all three buttons or watches disagree, the time of the intermediate button or watch shall be the time for that timing system.
 3. If only two button or watch times are available, the time shall be the average of those two buttons or watch times. The digits representing thousandths of a second shall be dropped with no rounding.
 4. If only one button or watch time is available, the time of that button or watch shall be the time for that timing system.

OFFICIALS:

- Each club is expected to supply 2 timers plus 1 recorder for one lane each day as well as place judges and stroke & turn judges. Please supply name and phone number of club contact person for deck officials. Smaller clubs (18 entries) may be delegated shared responsibilities.
